

House rules of Semmelweis University Freshman Ball

1. The rules of Semmelweis University Freshman Ball (the event) apply to all of the following people:
 - the participants of the event;
 - persons involved in organizing and conducting the event;
 - service providers involved in organizing and conducting the event
 - (eg security officers, buffet workers, performers, etc.), and other people who are employed or who are in a work relationship with the security officers, buffet workers, and performance)
 - any other people who visit the event.
2. The Territorial Scope of these Rules has to apply to the entire area of the Semmelweis University Freshman Ball. Entering and staying at the event is subject to these rules. Non-participants, any people who are not registered to be present in the event area will be immediately removed from the event area by the organizers.
3. Participants receive a wristband after registration and it entitles the wearer to enter the area of the event only once.
4. The organizers created these rules so that the participants could have a modest entertainment where they can make friends. However, the organizers may limit or stop any activities (especially illegal activities) that may pose danger to the physical integrity, health or life of the participants.
5. It is not allowed to bring any material or device that may damage the property or that may endanger the life, health or physical integrity of the participants. The following objects are not allowed at the site of the event: impact weapons, edged weapons, explosive or flammable substances (such as firecrackers), poisons, illegal drugs, etc. The organizers are entitled to search for and to confiscate these items. The security service is authorized to stop and to prevent the entry of these items therefore they are entitled to remove specific people from the event.
6. The organizers of the event may hire the services of a security service that takes care of personal security and the protection of property in accordance with the law of CXXXIII. of 2005. Members of the security service may inspect the clothing and the packages of the guests on entry and in throughout the event based on paragraph 26 of the law of CXXXIII. of 2005.
7. The event is protected and guarded by the organizers. It is the responsibility of the participants to protect their own values so it is their responsibility to bring any personal object, equipment or clothing to the site of the event. The organizers ask the participants that they should not bring an extraordinary amount of cash or high value items (like jewelry, technical items) to the site of the event.
8. It is not allowed to bring alcoholic beverages to the site of the event.
9. Any person who endangers the life, physical integrity of other people and any person who endangers other people's rights to their own property, endangers the integrity of other people's property or who endangers the natural environment of other people may be removed from the site of the event. Any person who exhibits an action that entitles police action to be taken against him or her or who incites aggression towards members of other social groups or whose action leads to unrest within the participants or who enters with prohibited items to the site of the event or who declines to remove prohibited items from the site of the event or who enters to the site of the event in any other designated area apart from the entrance may be removed from the site of the event. Any person who is subject to a restriction of age, or who has previously been removed from the site of the event or who has been banned by the organizers may be removed from the site of the event.
10. It is not allowed to perform any hazardous act at the site of the event: such action that may cause fire, accidents or that, which endangers the health of other people.
11. Everyone can use the equipment, tools, dance floor, etc. at the event. it is,

however, at the participant's own risk. Areas excluded from the participants and those may only be used by authorized persons if they can prove their right to use them. Damage resulting from improper use should be reimbursed by the person who caused the damage.

user is required to reimburse. The organizers have no responsibility for any personal injuries, accidents, and incidents that may happen during the usage of the installed games.

12. Anyone who unlawfully damages the valuable objects, the assets or equipment of the event is obliged to reimburse it.

13. The organizers of the event do not take any responsibility for any of the injuries of people and for any damages persons or in the materials that may occur during the event!

14. The participants shall immediately inform the organizers about any accidents, injuries or extraordinary incidents that occur in the event!

15. Everybody participates in the event of their own free will. The event is not compulsory for anybody. If any of the organized programs of the event is in conflict with the belief or the value system of a participant, he or she is not obliged to participate in that program. There are no tasks in the programs, which refer to sexuality. Participation is not considered voluntary if it happens due to group pressure.

16. Persons under the age of 18 may not be served with alcoholic beverages. The guests who are served at the counters may be asked to provide proof of their age by a credible document (such as an ID card or a passport).

17. The programs and the behavior and the communication of the participants of the event have to be in harmony with the values of the university and with the regulations of the Code of Ethics (available at www.semmelweis.hu) and of the Drug Prevention rules and with the general rules of the state of Hungary (available at www.njt.hu).

18. The organizers of the event reserve the right to change the programs of the event!

19. Participates may complain and/ or tell their comments to the organizers of the event at the site of the event either in person or by telephone or by sending an email to the organizers at the following address: vezetoseg@iocs.hu. In addition, participants may also complain to the Rector's Secretariat of the university in an anonymous way (rektor@semmelweis-univ.hu, Budapest 1085, Üllői út 26. I. em. 101., Telephone: 06 1 317 2400). The university will investigate all of the complaints, and the university will involve the competent authorities if necessary. All of the data of the participants who complain will kept confidential by the IÖCS group and by the university so these data will not be given to a third party.

20. The participants acknowledge the fact that if they do not abide by the rules of these regulations and in case there is a reasonable suspicion that they have committed a crime or an offense the security service has the right to arrest the perpetrators until the police arrive at the scene. In the event of a crime, the perpetrator can be intercepted by anybody who is present and that person shall report the perpetrator to the police. (see the Act of Indictment proceedings of 2017, XC, § 273 and see § 127 (3) of the Act of 1998) Participants acknowledge that the measures in this section are for their own safety. The participants acknowledge that the imposition of such measures on them does not constitute a restriction or violation of their freedom and movement.

21. In case of any violation of norms and / or legislation by a perpetrator who has a student status (within 5 months of the act), the University will initiate disciplinary proceedings for the events that have occurred. Disciplinary penalties may include:

- reprimand,
- severe reprimand,
- reduction of benefits provided in the Remuneration and Benefit Regulations; and reductions in benefits for a period not exceeding six months, or withdrawal of these benefits,
- the perpetrator may be banned from continuing his or her studies for a fixed period of up to two semesters

- exclusion from a higher education institution.

22. Any participant who is responsible for possession or consumption of drugs, may be searched by the security service. During the search procedure, the following people must be present: the person, who is accused of possession or consumption of drugs, the security guards who are in duty; Noémi Suszterics-Fülöp who is the president of the IÖCS team and Tamás Hegedüs the president of HÖK.

23. The event is a private community event organized by the organizers and other participants, therefore only such posters, flyers or presentations may be shown at the event which are allowed to be present by the organizers. These posters, flyers and presentations are in the interest of an organization that supports the community.

24. It is prohibited to take any photo, to make any video footage or sound recording, to store these and to publish these on the internet on any of the social media sites (such as Facebook, Flickr, Instagram, Tumblr, Twitter, YouTube etc.) which violate the personal freedom of any of the participants. It is prohibited to publish any of these after the event. The organizers of the event have the right to have any prohibited recordings deleted from social media sites.

25. The participant declares that he or she consent to the audio and video recordings taken of at his or her at the event that is made by the organizers of the event by entering the event or by having registered for the event and the participant consents to the fact that the organizers of the event can store these recordings and use these for their operation and they can submit them to Semmelweis University. The participant does not charge any money for the fact that these recordings are stored or used subsequently.

26. If a participant becomes aware that a recording has a content that is offensive to the participant or to another person the participant will immediately inform the organizers of the event so that they can take any action to investigate the recording and if necessary, they can delete the content.

27. According to the 65. § (3) a) of the Act CXII of 2011 on the right of information and the freedom of information (the so called Infotv) the NAIH does not keep records of the handling of this data.

28. Every participant is subject the rules specified above without exception.

29. The participant of the event has become familiar with the House Rules of Semmelweis University Freshman Ball and the participant declares that he or she will abide by these rules and declares that he or she participates in the Freshmen Ball on his or her own responsibility. The participant acknowledges that if he or she violates the restrictions that are listed in the House Rules he or she may be removed from the given program and if he or she violates the BTK rules of the state of Hungary it can result in the fact that he or she will be prosecuted. The participant is aware that the disciplinary punishment may include (but it is not limited to) the participant's disqualification from further studies from Semmelweis University.

30. We pay attention to protecting the physical integrity and health of all the participants, we respect their human dignity and their right to self determination. Within this framework the Rector of Semmelweis University has approved the program plan of the Freshman Ball in advance, however, the IÖCS team is responsible for ensuring that the ethical standards are met and enforced during the realization of the programs and the communication within the event of and related the Freshman Ball.
